As a reviewer you will be asked to review research proposals submitted for funding to the Canadian Council on Learning. The acceptability of your review requires an assessment of potential conflicts of interest. Please read the examples of potentially biasing affiliations or relationships listed in this document. If you feel there is a conflict of interest, please contact the CCL Project Manager who will determine if you should conduct the review.

**POTENTIAL CONFLICTS OF INTEREST FOR
CCL REVIEWERS**

1 RELATIONSHIP WITH PRINCIPAL INVESTIGATORS OR PROJECT LEADER:

1. Do you have a known family or marriage relationship with principal investigators or project leader?
2. Do you have a business relationship with the principal investigators or project leader?
3. Do you have other relationships with the principal investigators or project leader, such as a personal friendship and/or a working relationship that might tend to affect your judgment or be seen as doing so by a reasonable person familiar with the relationship?

2 RELATIONSHIP TO RESPONDENT:

1. Does the respondent currently employ you in any capacity?
2. Is the respondent considering you for employment or in any contractual capacity?
3. Have you been employed by the respondent within the last 12 months?
4. Do you have any ownership of the respondent's securities?
5. Are you a holder of any office or appointment, governing board membership, or relevant committee chair with the respondent?
6. Have you received an honorarium, award or compensation of any form by the respondent within the last 12 months?
